NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

STATE OF CONNECTICUT HEALTH AND  
EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES AUTHORITY  
REVENUE BONDS, KENT SCHOOL ISSUE, SERIES H

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the State of Connecticut Health and Educational Facilities Authority (the "Authority"), on April 19, 2017 commencing at 10:00 a.m., at the office of the Authority, 10 Columbus Boulevard, 7th Floor, Hartford, Connecticut 06106-1978, for the purpose of providing a reasonable opportunity for interested individuals to express their views, either orally or in writing, as to the authorization and issuance by the Authority of the above-captioned bonds (the "Bonds") and the nature of the projects described below. The Authority has been requested to make available the proceeds from the sale of the Bonds to be issued in an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$20,000,000, to finance a loan to The Kent School Corporation (the "Institution"), a nonprofit institution duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Connecticut, to provide moneys for the purposes of reimbursing the Institution or otherwise to provide funds to the Institution for the following: (a) the refinancing of all or a portion of outstanding revenue bonds of the Authority, captioned State of Connecticut Health and Educational Facilities Authority Revenue Bonds, Kent School Issue, Series F; (b) the financing or refinancing of the costs of (i) the construction and equipping of an approximately 10,200 square foot squash facility containing eight (8) international squash courts; (ii) the construction of an approximately 1,000 square foot main entry to connect the existing Tennis House and the new squash facility; (iii) renovation and equipping of existing squash courts for conversion to a multi-purpose athletic space; (iv) the demolition of two (2) tennis courts situated on the northwesterly side of Skiff Mountain Road and the northeasterly side of Macedonia Road (Route 341), also known as 3D Skiff Mountain Road, Kent, Connecticut, and (v) other capital expenditures for improvements and/or equipment related to the foregoing, or related to providing secondary education, all of the foregoing which are or will be owned and or operated or leased to and used by the Institution on the campus of the Institution located at 1 Macedonia Road (Route 341) and 3D Skiff Mountain Road, Kent Connecticut; (c) the funding of capitalized interest, if any, on the Bonds; (d) the funding of certain reserve funds and accounts; and (e) the payment of certain costs of issuance with respect to the Bonds. The Series F Bonds were issued for the purposes of reimbursing the Institution or otherwise to provide funds to the Institution for the following: (a) the refinancing of all or a portion of outstanding revenue bonds of the Authority, captioned State of Connecticut Health and Educational Facilities Authority Variable Rate Demand Revenue Bonds, Kent School Issue, Series E (the "Series E Bonds"); (b) the financing or refinancing of the costs of (i) the construction, renovation and equipping of approximately 8,675 square feet of space in the Dining Hall Dorm for music use such as rehearsal and practice rooms, offices, classrooms, computer lab and storage; (ii) the construction, renovation and equipping of approximately 16,107 square feet of the Mattison Auditorium for theatre and auditorium use, together with lobby and gallery space, dressing rooms, storage, and a drama workshop, both the Dining Hall Dorm and the Mattison Auditorium being located on the Institution's campus at 1 Macedonia Road (Route 341), Kent, Connecticut; (iii) other capital expenditures for improvements and/or equipment related to the foregoing, including renovations and modifications for building and fire code compliance or related to providing secondary education, all of the foregoing which are or will be owned and or operated or leased to and used by the Institution on the campus of the Institution located at 1 Macedonia Road (Route 341) and 3D Skiff Mountain Road, Kent Connecticut; (c) the funding of capitalized interest, if any, on the Series F Bonds; (d) the funding of certain reserve funds and accounts; and (e) the payment of certain costs of issuance with respect to the Series F Bonds. The Series E Bonds were issued for the purposes of reimbursing the Institution or otherwise to provide funds to the Institution for the following: (i) the refinancing of all of the outstanding revenue bonds of the Authority, captioned State of Connecticut Health and Educational Facilities

Authority Revenue Bonds, Kent School Issue, Series C (the "Series C Bonds"); (ii) the financing or refinancing of the costs of (1) the construction, renovation and equipping of approximately 3,510 square feet of additions and renovations to the fitness center that is a portion of the 63,081 square foot athletic facility known as the Magowan Field House situated on the northwesterly side of Skiff Mountain Road and the northeasterly side of Macedonia Road (Route 341), also known as 3D Skiff Mountain Road, Kent, Connecticut, and (2) other capital expenditures for improvements and/or equipment related to the foregoing, including renovations and modifications for building and fire code compliance, or related to providing secondary education, all of the foregoing which are or will be owned and operated or leased to and used by the Institution on the campus of the Institution located at 1 Macedonia Road (Route 341) and 3D Skiff Mountain Road, Kent, Connecticut. The Series C Bonds were issued for the purposes of financing or refinancing a portion of the costs of (i) the renovation of approximately 17,740 square feet of a 42,000 square foot student dormitory building known as the Middle Dorm and the expansion thereof by approximately 19,500 square feet, (ii) the renovation of the Institution's administration building, a structure of approximately 11,000 square feet, (iii) the renovation of portions of an approximately 46,759 square foot building known as the Schoolhouse, and (iv) other capital expenditures for improvements and/or equipment related to the foregoing or related to providing secondary education on the campus of the Institution located at 1 Macedonia Road (Route 341), Kent Connecticut.

Interested members of the public are invited to attend. Individuals desiring to make a brief statement regarding the foregoing projects should give prior notice in writing to the Authority at the address shown below at least 24 hours prior to the hearing. Written comments may be submitted to the Authority at the address shown below.
